

TICKETING TERMS & CONDITIONS

A _____ of _____ (**Ticketholder**) has purchased a ticket from InnerOrigin Pty Limited (**Company**) to attend a Wellness Event arranged and hosted by the Company (**Event**).

B The Ticketholder agrees to attend the Event on the following terms and conditions:

1 Recording

- 1.1 The Ticketholder consents to being recorded, filmed and photographed during its attendance of the Event.
- 1.2 The Company will have the unlimited and exclusive right to take photographs and manufacture audio and/or audio-visual products relating the Event (**Materials**) and may exploit the Materials by any method and for any purpose whatsoever in all media and all markets throughout the world.
- 1.3 The Company may prohibit the Ticketholder from bringing any camera or any handheld audio, video or electronic recording device into the Event and the Ticketholder acknowledges that it may not record, publish or broadcast any images, audio and/or audio-visual content relating to the Event (including broadcast and publication through the internet) unless it has obtained the prior written consent of the Company.

2 Content

- 2.1 The Company may alter the program and content of the Event prior to or during the Event and reserves the right to do so without notice to the Ticketholder.
- 2.2 The Ticketholder acknowledges that the Company is not responsible for any recommendations, claims, opinions, information or advice (**Content**) expressed by any guest speaker during the Event.
- 2.3 The Company does not claim or assert that the Content is a cure or treatment for any disease, illness, disorder or disability and the Ticketholder acknowledges that the Content has not been evaluated by the Therapeutic Goods Administration.
- 2.4 The Ticketholder shall not make or bring any action, suit, claim or demand against the Company for any loss suffered or incurred by the Ticketholder relating to or in connection with the Content whether consequential or otherwise.

3 Behaviour

- 3.1 No alcohol, dangerous or illegal substances may be brought to the Event by the Ticketholder and the Ticketholder must behave in a lawful and appropriate manner at all times. The Company reserves the right to refuse the Ticketholder admission or to require the Ticketholder to leave the Event and the Ticketholder acknowledges that no refunds will be given in this event.

4 Ticket Conditions

- 4.1 Tickets to the Event are not transferable and may not be resold or offered for resale or used in connection with any advertising or promotion or commercial purpose which is not approved by the Company. Any ticket to the Event used in breach of these terms and conditions may be cancelled and admission refused.
- 4.2 Tickets to the Event cannot be refunded, exchanged or cancelled once issued to the Ticketholder except in accordance with the applicable laws of New South Wales, Australia.

5 Force Majeure

- 5.1 Under no circumstances will the Company be held liable for any direct or indirect acts of nature or forces or causes beyond the Company's reasonable control including without limitation fires, floods, storms, explosions, earthquakes or any other acts of God.
